

Burn off notification

The following information is required to register your burn-off:

Location Full street address, including nearest intersection. For large land holders, include where on your property you will conduct the burn-off. <i>This helps to identify the exact location in Victoria.</i>	
Premises / property name <i>If applicable.</i>	
Map Reference <i>If known and please indicate details of map type e.g. Melway, Spatial Vision.</i>	
Will fire burn continuously overnight?	<input type="checkbox"/> YES Ensure council/permit regulations for patrolling burns overnight are complied with <input type="checkbox"/> NO
Start date and time- intended to light up <i>Have you checked the weather forecast? Are the weather conditions calm for the burn?</i>	Start date: Start time:
