


You can now start the module by clicking on the title 'Bushfire Planning: You and the person you care for' or the 'rightpointing' arrow. Follow the module instructions

Once the module is completed it will turn green

If you exit and return and return you can resume where you left off by clicking on the module or the yellow circle 'In progress' icon '

### Part 3 – Accessing a Certificate of Completion

Click on the '<u>Completed</u>' menu item in the 'Learning Status' menu to bring up a list of your completed modules


In this case 'Bushfire Safety for Workers' is shown. If you have completed other modules they will also be on the list and the process is the same

#### 1. What if the module is not working properly on my computer?

Most likely it is a problem with your internet browser. Make sure you are using a recent version of either Chrome or Firefox as Internet Explorer may not run the module properly.

### 2. Can I do the module on my phone?

This online module is designed to operate from a computer or laptop and may not work effectively from your phone. It will also make it hard to see some of the text on a small phone screen.

### 3. Can I do the module again?

Once completed you can still go back and do the module again. In fact, CFA recommends you do a refresher every year. However, once you have completed it, it will list your record as completed.
